

Algorithm Point of Entry Staff Screening

Staff member presenting, must maintain 2 metres physical distancing or greater during the screening process.

Ask: *Do you have any of the following symptoms+:*

- Fever (greater than 38 degrees Celsius) or chills?
- “New” onset of cough or an increase in the amount you cough?
- Shortness of breath?
- Headache – new or unusual headache for you?
- Sore throat?
- Sore muscles not related to overexertion or exercise?

+ NOTE: this does not include chronic or seasonal allergies

Instruct staff to:

- notify their department/site and then their manager and local Infection Prevention & Control practitioner as soon as possible,
- Self-isolate until advised otherwise and
- Maintain physical distancing from individuals within their home

Provide Staff Screening – [Self Isolate letter](#) to staff.

Tracking and reporting of staff screened out/or positive is documented.

Staff member is cleared to proceed to work today, and asked to use hand sanitizer before proceeding.

Screener –

- **Maintain two metres or greater physical distance. Universal Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is not required if significantly greater distance than two metres is maintained or physical barrier exists.**
